

For the 100+ new club members in the last few months, this is a great chance to meet and greet band members, have some fun the club and hear us perform. We are always recruiting people who want to learn to play bagpipes and/or drums! A few band members have their kids in the band also. Anyone who wants to learn to play is encouraged to join as all are welcome. Like the club, the Pipe Band is a family orientated great group of people and we have a fun together whether we are at rehearsals or events performing. More information on lessons and rehearsals (right here at the club) is below.

We do have an event just a week later on August 5<sup>th</sup> at Irish Heritage Night at the Blueclaws game that evening to support the club members involved in organizing that event!

Every month we have at least one event and/or a parade (usually a fundraiser for someone or an organization) along with weekly rehearsals.

There are events in September and October include:

We teach for free anyone that has the desire to learn to play! We have a few new band members that need kilt and uniforms, a few more snare drums to replace the used drums purchased almost 20 years ago that we are still using and of course other items (for example reeds, cap badges, drum heads).

The club and club members have been very generous to the band over the years. With your continued support, we have been able to grow and start replacing worn out equipment. The band would not be where we are now without your support! THANK YOU!!!!!

Over 19 years ago this band was started and performed about 25% of the time for charities. That

percentage has increased quite a bit as the majority of our performances are for charities. Sometimes it's a lone bagpiper, sometimes it's the entire band performing. We always try our best to accommodate all requests as I explain each month (see below).






