## Irish History #72

## Michael Collins Avenges Tom Clarke's Humiliation at the Conclusion of the Rising

The Irish War of Independence was waged in a ruthless and bloody fashion a century ago. In June 1920, Michael Collins fulfilled a pledge he made to himself four years earlier on the heels of the Easter Rising.

After Padraig Pearse surrendered to British General William Lowe on the Rising's sixth day, rebel prisoners were detained overnight on the grounds of Rotunda Maternity Hospital in Dublin. Collins was one of them. Some British soldiers beat and abused prisoners held there, including rebel leaders Tom Clarke and Sean MacDiarmada.

According to Tim Pat Coogan, the conduct of British Captain Percival Lea Wilson stood out as particularly savage. He ordered all prisoners needing to relieve themselves to do so where they sat on Rotunda grounds. MacDiarmada suffered from polio and needed a cane to walk. Wilson took that and beat MacDiarmada with it. Wilson also had Clarke - a 58 year "old Fenian" - stripped naked. Clarke had a bandaged bullet wound. Wilson had the bandage torn-off during the stripping. He also ordered Clarke beaten. Collins spent the night trying to comfort Clarke.

Pearse and Clarke, along with Tomas
MacDonough, were the first of the Rising's leaders
to be executed at Kilmainham Jail. MacDiarmada
was executed with James Connolly nine days later.
During that short timeframe, fifteen rebel leaders,
including the seven who signed the Proclamation
of the Irish Republic (Pearse, Clarke, MacDonagh,
Joseph Plunkett, Eamonn Ceannt, Connolly and
MacDiarmada), were court-martialed, sentenced to
death and shot by a firing squad.

The British hoped these killings would close the chapter on the Easter Rising by deterring further acts of rebellion. But the quick executions had the opposite effect. They hardened the Irish populace against the British and in favor of independence. "Home Rule" for Ireland was no longer enough. In this way, the Rising served as the beginning of a war for independence from Great Britain. That dream would be realized nearly six years later.

For Collins, the long, drizzly hours the rebels spent on the hospital grounds was a night to reamember. Not just because the Rising had failed, but also because of Wilson's mistreatment of Clarke and MacDiarmada.

Wilson, who joined the British Army in World War I (WWI), was stationed in Dublin after being wounded in battle. He was there at the time of the Rising. After WWI, he served as a Royal Irish Constabulary (RIC) Inspector in Co. Wexford. Collins found out and plotted retribution.

Collins sent two members of his "Intelligence Squad" - Liam Tobin and Frank Thornton - to Wexford. They, along with three others, waited for Wilson as he walked home one evening from a RIC barracks. The five were there to carry out Collins' order to kill Wilson. The men stood around a parked car with its hood up. They shot Wilson as he passed-by. Although hit by the initial gunfire, Wilson tried to get away by running up the street. He was felled by additional shots. Tobin and Thornton walked-up to Wilson's body and made sure he was dead. He had been shot seven times.

Word about Wilson's death got back to Collins in Dublin that evening. Irish Central News reported

that Collins reacted to the news with "joy" and told those with him "well we finally got the b\*\*\*\*\*d." In Collins' view, he had served a dish of "just deserts" to Wilson and settled the score.

Collins re-opened the book on Wilson's heartless behavior at the hospital four years earlier. And, in having Wilson killed, Collins closed it with an exclamation point!

"Go dti go mbuailfimid le cheile aris, go bhfanfaidh sibh go leir slan sabhalte." (Until we meet again, may you all remain safe and well.)
