# Ordinary Men and Women Helped Win the Irish War of Independence

A recent Irish Times news article carried a headline: "Michael Collins importance in the War of Independence has been exaggerated." If alive today, Eamon de Valera would certainly agree with that statement. He spent a lifetime suppressing the historical truth about Collins' contribution to Ireland's independence and nationhood.

The article made two points. First, outside of Dublin, the IRA "was highly decentralized, with GHQ (General Headquarters) exercising nominal control over its provincial brigades." Second, the article attributed the war's success to the unheralded, ordinary people who supported the IRA insurgency.

IRA Brigades in counties beyond Dublin financed and armed themselves. They were responsible for their own operations. Guerilla warfare fighting developed not as part of a central plan but more as a local strategy "characterized by ingenuity, adaptability and flexibility in an ever-changing military situation." The "flying column" was an example of how the guerilla war was waged.

The August 1920 Restoration of Order in Ireland Act authorized internment and courts-martial for civilians, and led to the arrest of IRA fighters. As a result, many Irish Volunteers went "on-the-run." The Irish populace provided them safe houses to hideout and avoid capture. Many of the on-the-runs were selected to join "flying columns," who deployed hit and run tactics against British security forces. Engagements were chosen where it was possible to inflict more casualties on the enemy than would be suffered by the column.

The tactics resulted in the destruction of roads, bridges, and railways. Additionally, police barracks were destroyed or seized. One example from 1920 involved the capture of Ballytrain Barracks by the Monaghan Brigade. The garrison's weapons and ammunition were seized.

Flying Columns also conducted thousands of ambushes on British forces. The most famous was the Kilmichael ambush in 1920. An IRA flying column led by Tom Barry wiped-out a British military patrol near

Macroom, Co. Cork. The patrol was traveling in two Crossley Tenders. On reaching the kill zone, they were attacked by the IRA from both sides of the road. The flying column killed 17 Auxiliaries, while losing three men.

Operational successes like these were the direct result of local efforts.

The Dublin Brigade was an exception to the decentralization thesis. Great Britain exercised control over Ireland from its Dublin Castle headquarters. Therefore, IRA strength in Ireland's capital was crucial to the overall war effort. In addition to its military significance, fighting the British at its seat of power had important psychological and propaganda value. GHQ, located in Dublin, exercised authority over the Dublin Brigade. Collins' military influence was most effective here. In addition, Collins' Intelligence Squad was based in Dublin. Throughout the war's duration, the Intelligence Squad and the Dublin Brigade inflicted grievous losses on British forces.

It appeared that a "mass movement" among the populace supported the IRA. The movement included individuals who never fired a gun but "watched for raiding crown forces, hid arms, intercepted British communications, scouted for republican fugitives, delivered messages and carried out other critical, if unglamorous, tasks." Some of these important things were performed by members of the IRA. Often, however, the mission was carried out by civilians including republican women from the Cumann na mBan. When Irish Volunteers procured guns, ammunition and gelignite in Liverpool, Great Britain, they relied on Irish ship captains, sailors and custom inspectors - civilians - to transport the items across the Irish Sea. Another example making it evident to the British that they were dealing with a movement occurred when crowds gathered outside of prisons and sang "A Soldier's Song" for the IRA men inside.

The Cumann na mBan was formed in 1914 as the

female affiliate of the Irish Volunteers. Its members, including Countess Constance Markievicz who fought at St. Stephen's Green, took part in the Easter Rising. Women of the Cumann na mBan were also deeply involved in the War of Independence. They cared for members of flying columns who were injured or sick. They provided them food and cigarettes. Women were especially important in keeping communication and intelligence networks functioning. They carried messages from GHQ to regional brigades and between units within the same brigade. Some went undercover to befriend British soldiers and gather intelligence.

Women intercepted British communications, monitored British forces and identified spies. The information they gathered was passed on to GHQ and local commanders. Individuals who associated with the enemy where viewed as "potential spies." Those individuals were warned that their continued association would carry consequences, and that spies were subject to execution.

Collins received information about the identity of British agents operating at Dublin Castle and where they lived from a woman who worked as a "shorthand typist" at the Castle. He used the information to kill 13 members of the British Intelligence Cairo Gang on November 21, 1920 - "Bloody Sunday."

Cumann na mBan members also watched over arms caches, and transported guns and ammunition "concealed in luggage or underneath clothing." At IRA funerals, they dressed in uniform and marched behind uniformed Irish Volunteers.

The women of the Cumann na mBan displayed great courage in performing all of these tasks. Beyond their support of the military effort, they were politically engaged. The Cumann na mBan collected for the Dail Loan and helped distribute money to prisoners' dependents.

They participated in the Dail's boycott of Royal Irish Constabulary police officers and their families. Senior members bolstered the Dail's propaganda activities by advocating for Ireland's independence in Europe and America. In 1921, six of its members were elected to the Second Dail.

What all of this shows is that ordinary men and women did extraordinary things that made victory possible. They are the unsung heroes of the Irish War of Independence. We should all recognize the impact of their contributions while simultaneously appreciating the critical role played by Michael Collins.


